CLASSES

Beginning Crochet: Magic Potholders with Jody

For kids & adults
Saturday, April 3, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
\$10 plus supplies

A perfect first project — these simple potholders are quick and easy to make. Watch as your straight line of stitches magically turns back on itself to make a double-layered square! Choose your favorite color of worsted weight, superwash yarn; bring an F or G crochet hook; and whip up some potholders.

Quilting with Erick Wolfmeyer (three-part class)

Thursdays, April 8, 15, 22, 6 to 8 p.m.
\$75 + supplies

Be inspired by local quilter, Erick Wolfmeyer (www.ewolfmeyerquilts.com), and learn how to machine piece, hand quilt and finish a quilt with binding. At the end of this class you will have a completed small quilted table mat or runner.

Dyeing Basics: Start to Finish

Saturday, April 10, 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Fees: \$75, with supply fee \$8

This class covers dye primer and safety, mixing dyes and thickeners, painting and low water immersion dyeing, steaming, rinsing and washing techniques — all the little tricks of the trade not covered in shorter sessions. The focus will be on learning rather than

beautiful finished products. Taught by local fiber artist Astrid Hilger Bennett. **Bring old clothes, rubber gloves, dust mask, plastic bag.**

Summer Terrariums

For kids of all ages
Sunday, April 11, noon to 2 p.m.
\$20, bring one or two mason jars or pasta jars, or one big, one small jar, other supplies included.
Make fabric plants, flowers, butterflies and insects out of buttons and trimmings and place them in mason jar terrariums to get ourselves ready for spring.

Jersey Skirt

Monday, April 12, 5:30 to 8 p.m.
\$25, pattern included
Try our new super soft and light bamboo cotton jersey fabric. This gathered skirt has a doubled waistband.

Simple Lace Shawl

Wednesdays, April 14 and 28, 6 to 8 p.m.
\$40 + lace or fingering yarn, US 6 needles, pattern included
Learn basic shaping for a shawl and a simple lace pattern using yarnovers and decreases. Choose from Araucania 100 percent cashmere, Noro Sekku, Zauberball, Spud and Chloe, or Malabrigo — we have a lots of yarn perfect for this shawl. Bring scrap yarn and spare needles to swatch lace pattern. Blocking lace will be covered, too!

Headbands with Heather!

\$32 to make two headbands, supplies included!

Add flair to your spring and summer wardrobe with a handmade, fabulously embellished headband.

Embellishments will include feathers, miniature birds, flowers, netting, ribbon and other tiny treasures.

Beginning Sewing: Pillowcases

Saturday, April 17, 1 to 3:30 p.m.

\$50, all supplies included

Mix and match fun fabrics and stitch your own pair of pillowcases. This project is excellent for beginning sewers.

Tent and Flag

For kids ages 6 to 12

Sunday April 18, 10 a.m. to noon

\$20, bring one yard of fabric, other supplies included.

Students will sew and collage a portable fabric tent and flag for their dolls or stuffed animals to play in.

Beginning Socks with Nancy

Tuesdays, April 20, 27 and May 4, 6 to 7:30 p.m.

\$40, pattern included

If you can cast on, knit and purl, you can make socks!

Learn to knit cuff down socks one at a time on two sets of US 3 or 4 circular needles using worsted weight yarn. A small, portable project for spring and summer knitting.

Simple Sewing & Crochet: Granny Square Pillow with Jody

Wednesdays, April 21 and May 5, 6 to 8 p.m.

\$40, supplies included, bring an F or G crochet hook

Use two techniques to create a colorful spring pillow. First crochet a granny square using Noro Kureyon yarn — the color variations are beautiful and perfectly suited to this

crochet square. Then learn to sew and stuff a simple pillow, and sew the crocheted square on top to show it off.

Family Trees

Saturday, April 24, 3 to 5 p.m.

\$35, supplies included

If you were interested in making the bird mobile, this project uses the same bird pattern. Make stuffed birds, squirrels, butterflies, fruit, and acorns to represent your family members. These will be arranged on real branches as a mobile or standing object for your home.

May Day Baskets with Jody

Learn to make simple May baskets in plenty of time to celebrate May Day. Students will use fabric, Heat & Bond, bias tape, and trims to create two small baskets. Leave a basket at your favorite person's door on May 1! (Please note: we will be using hot items such as the iron and hot glue gun.)
